





Hull Public Access Bleed & Trauma Kits

IN THE CASE OF A SERIOUS BLEED CALL 999 IMMEDIATELY AND TAKE GUIDANCE FROM THE OPERATOR. DO NOT LEAVE THE CASUALTY ALONE TO RECOVER ONE OF THESE KITS.

<u>What Is It?</u> – Bleed and Trauma Kits is a single point of emergency equipment which can provide lifesaving initial care to someone who suffers a serious bleed through whatever means. In the case of a serious bleed these few minutes can be vital, and this kit helps untrained members of the public provide support until medical personnel arrive.

What Is In The Kit? – Inside the kit is basic equipment such as a tourniquet, bandages and dressings. None of this kit requires training and there is a guidance sheet in the kits themselves. PPE is also included such as gloves.
